When running power outside, a GFCI-equipped outlet is required by code in all areas exposed to moisture, such as the outdoors, and ensures safety. When adding an outdoor outlet, be sure to choose an outdoor-rated, weatherproof model with built-in, high-sensitivity GFCI.

What makes a good outdoor outlet?

The outlet should be weather and tamper-resistant, with a Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) for protection against electrical shocks. Beyond design, the outlet should be installed away from places prone to pooling water, and the outdoor outlet box should be securely anchored to the wall.






