

# **What is the Gambia communication base station**

What telecommunications are available in the Gambia?

Telecommunications in the Gambia includes radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. Radio: The state-owned Gambia Radio and Television Service has two AM stations (Bonto, Basse) and three FM stations (Bonto, Serrekunda, Banjul). There are also seven private FM stations in Serrekunda, Banjul, and Basse.

How many radio stations are there in the Gambia?

Today, there are five more radio stations in the Gambia. Main lines: 64,200 lines in use, 159th in the world (2012). Mobile cellular: 1.5 million lines, 151st in the world (2012). Teledensity: ~80 per 100 persons, combined fixed-line and mobile-cellular (2011).

What is the telecom market composition in Gambia?

Gambia's telecom market is dominated by the state-owned Gamtel, which



retains a monopoly on fixed-line telephony services. Four mobile networks provide effective competition. The market's leader is Africell (owned by American), with about 65% market share.

What happened to the Internet in the Gambia?

Since 30 November 2016, the evening before the presidential election, internet access, mobile communication and phone calls have been completely shut down by all providers, as ordered by the president of The Gambia. Africell, mobile telecommunications company operating in The Gambia, Sierra Leone, and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Who owns Comium Gambia?

Comium, Comium Gambia Co. Ltd., Telecommunications Company, is fully owned subsidiary of the Comium Group Luxemburg. Netpage Ltd., Netpage Gambia Co. Ltd., Telecommunications Company. Quantum Ltd., QuantumNet Gambia Co. Ltd., Telecommunications Company.

Does the Gambia have 5G?

Currently, none of the network operators in the Gambia are providing 5G services. Africell and QCELL are the only network operators currently providing 4G coverage and are both focused on expanding their 4G network nationwide. Internet connectivity into The Gambia is managed by Gamtel, with bandwidth sold to other ISPs.

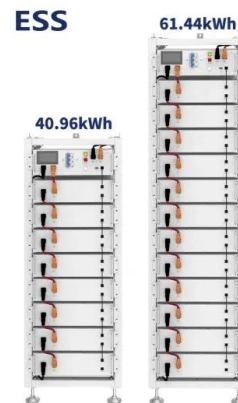

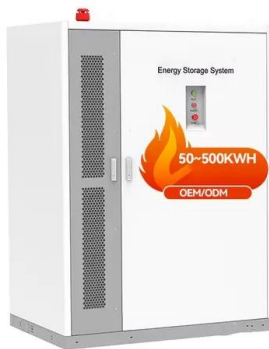
